



AFTER HOURS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following conditions of entry apply to all visitors attending Wentworth Point Community Centre and Library (WPCCL) during the afterhours shown in the below table. This includes the quiet study and central lounge areas. The conditions of entry apply to all visitors.

These Conditions of Entry should be read in conjunction with the overarching Wentworth Point Community Centre and Library (Community Hub) - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Authorised afterhours access is restricted to:

- 1.1. Current City of Parramatta Library members who are over the age of 16 and have been formally inducted by a City of Parramatta Library Services Staff Member on the terms and conditions of use of the afterhours/quiet study facility.
- 1.2. Current Community Hirers and their After Hours Access Users with a valid booking and active access codes.

2. Child Safety

- 2.1. Children under the age of 16 years accessing the centre after-hours must be always accompanied and supervised by an adult (parent/ guardian of the child) with authorised access privileges. Unaccompanied minors will be denied access to the centre after-hours. Council reserves the right to contact parents or carers of any child under 16 years for whom there are concerns or to notify the appropriate agency if required.

3. Inappropriate Behaviour

- 3.1. Visitors must not engage in behaviour that is likely to interfere with the safety, comfort or convenience of other people within the Premises. Or that is likely to damage or result in the unauthorised use of the Hubs facilities within the WPCCL.
- 3.2. Visitors who cause a disturbance or refuse to comply with any requests made by Council staff or their agents will be denied entry or asked to leave the premises. Any Visitor who attempts to enter the premises after being asked to leave will be immediately reported to the NSW Police.

- 3.3. Smoking or the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted on the premises or outdoors within 4 metres of a pedestrian access point to the building.
